Report of Personnel Committee activities - 2013

Management Plan

A management reorganization plan was implemented this year. The objective was to create an organizational structure that would reflect the duties and responsibilities of staff; provide a strategic overlap of positions; promote interaction between operational layers; and position the organization to manage programs and workload increases effectively.

Two new positions were created; Executive Director and Lead Telecommunicator. The Operations Director position was retained and the job description was revised. A selection process was initiated for each position and the following candidates were selected:

Executive Director

Tyler Millix

Operations Director

Scott Haddad

• Lead Telecommunicator

Jeff Ruest

Employment contracts were negotiated with the individuals selected for the two administrative positions and negotiations were entered into with CILU #76 concerning the Lead Telecommunicator position.

A new rotating work schedule was implemented to insure a supervisory presence during certain periods and strategic overlap of personnel.

Contract Negotiations with CILU #76

As mentioned above, contract negotiations were entered into concerning the Lead Telecommunicator position. Agreement was reached on a pay grade for the position and a new work schedule was created.

Lead Telecommunicator

The selection process for Lead Telecommunicator was conducted. It included an application/resume review, interview with the Personnel Committee, and an Executive Director interview. Jeff Ruest was selected for the position.

Finance Director Performance Review

Finance Director Turner's Performance Review was completed. The Personnel Committee rated the Finance Director's Performance over the last year (ending June 30th) as <u>Excellent</u>.

Operations Director Performance Review

Operations Director Haddad's Performance Review was completed. The Personnel Committee rated the Operations Director's Performance at the end of his six month probationary period (October 2013) as Excellent.

Full Time / Part Time Dispatcher position hiring

The Service conducted two separate hiring processes for both part time and full time positions. Two full time and two part time positions were hired and applicants retained. The Service continually evaluates the workforce and cost efficient scheduling options.

Personnel Resources / Management Programs

An Employee Assistance Program (EAP) and Drug Free Workplace program were implemented. The management team continues to assess system performance while concurrently working to formalize the structure of a Quality Assurance program to insure superior service continues to be provided to member departments.

January 15, 2014 Annual County Meeting Report

Your Radio Committee had another busy but productive year. We had several regular plus several special meetings as issues arose.

During this past year the following accomplishments or issue were addressed.

- The East Windsor 153.125 Tone and Voice paging radio was replaced.
- A new 33.78 crossband radio as well as several other new replacement upgrade radios were installed at Bald Hill Tolland
- We received FCC license approval to expand the 453/458.275 UHF radio system to 5 additional tower sites.
- A complete new low band/UHF radio system was installed at Hebron Station 10 in preparation for their move to TN.
- Several meetings and discussions were held in preparation to drawing specifications and ordering the new Dispatch Center Furniture. Equipment was ordered from Wright Line and is scheduled for installation second week of January 2014.
- Replacement Radio Dispatching equipment demos were held, along with several meetings to further investigate the replacement options for the old Orbacom system. Avtec was selected as the new replacement vendor. Final configurations will be prepared in early 2014.
- Along with the Avtec recommended vendor, the Board approved a joint venture with QV to move forward with the development of a new interface required to mate this new system with the existing New World CAD system. We want to make sure that this interface is developed prior to any installation of the new Avtec system at TN. Hopefully QV will receive this prior to our system being ready and would have time to iron out any potential bugs with the new interface.
- A new UHF Control Station was installed at TN to allow TN's access to the Bolton and Hebron crossband radios.
- With the moving of Hebron to TN, KX reassigned their UHF link to the VHF paging radio (153.125) at Birch Mountain to another user. This required TN to purchase a new UHF link radio to that existing radio at this site.
- We had a visit to the UConn Tower site to discuss the option of TN placing equipment there for expanded coverage. Tentative approvals were received and we have submitted our equipment requirements for final approval.
- A major milestone was achieved with the cross muting of the radios in the dispatch center during 33.80 toning. This had been a sore spot for several years and with the replacement of most of the old radios with the newer radios with additional option capabilities we were able to finally solve this issue.
- This past fall we had a major failure of our older microwave system connecting the Dispatch Center with Bald Hill. Through the efforts of our vendor (Tactical Communications from Guilford) we were only down for a short period during which they were able to receive emergency shipments of temporary replacements. Along with this equipment and an emergency tower climbing crew, we were back in a single system operation mode within a couple of days. This is only a temporary fix and we have recently met with the vendor for a more permanent fix consisting of a more robust system with expanded channel capability and dual redundant hot standby features. This new system will allow us to totally eliminate the current phone cable connection from the Dispatch Center to Bald Hill. This system is now on order (costs around

\$200,000.00) and should be installed in the next three (3) months. Within that estimated cost Tactical has agreed to take back some of the recently installed emergency equipment for credits.

- We again spent some time looking into our UPS backup system at the Dispatch Center but due
 to the work load and expenses this past year have not had time to devote our full attention to this
 issue. The current unit is considerably overloaded.
- We also completed the addition of a radio control link from the Board/ EOC Room to a radio in the Dispatch Room allowing additional communications during times the EOC is activated.
- The current storage facility at Kingsbury Ave, Tolland was emptied of all old equipment and the lease is being terminated.
- TN holds several FCC Radio Licenses which must be constantly monitored by our Committee along with our Consultant. Regular renewal periods must be addressed along with any site changes or additions we make during the year. It seems this results in a constant process for us.

Looking ahead we see another very busy year for your Radio Committee.

In conclusion, although this project is far from over, I want to add that over the past several days during the Dispatch Center carpeting and furniture upgrade, I spent only a small portion of my time there compared to the time put in by your Dispatching Supervisors and Staff. From the prior planning and coordination of all outside services required to make this project come to fruition along with the work efforts I have observed during this process need to be commended. The staff has put in an extreme amount of hours, sometimes into the wee hours of the morning that should be noted. As for the on duty Dispatching Personnel, during this period, as I observed, just to be able to maintain normal operations with all that is going on around them and in the midst of the noise, the many workers present and activities and have still are able to professionally monitor and handle emergency calls needs to be recognized. In the midst of this all they have to put up with me taking progress photos for our future history documentation.

And this is only the first step in our Dispatch Center upgrade as the next step will be to replace our current obsolete Radio Dispatching system which will also prove to be a major project. After observing the current efforts I am very confident that this phase will also be well coordinated and approached with the same professionalism.

I am sure I can speak for the entire Board in expressing our recognition and appreciation to all the staff for your efforts.

We are working on some guidance for all departments that explains the capabilities of the vehicle and examples of appropriate events where it will be useful as well as dispel some myths on its capabilities. Please look for this document in the coming days. The vehicle will be on display both before and after the Annual Meeting.

Dispatch Furniture RFP

The new furniture install began on Monday and is progressing well. The project should be complete by the end of the upcoming weekend. If any departments are interested in visiting the center please coordinate through Scott once everything is completed.

IT Topics

CAD work continues with run card modifications and cell/alpha changes. Copious amounts of time have been spent preparing for the new consoles. Most computers are now remoted to the radio room and new programs installed.
